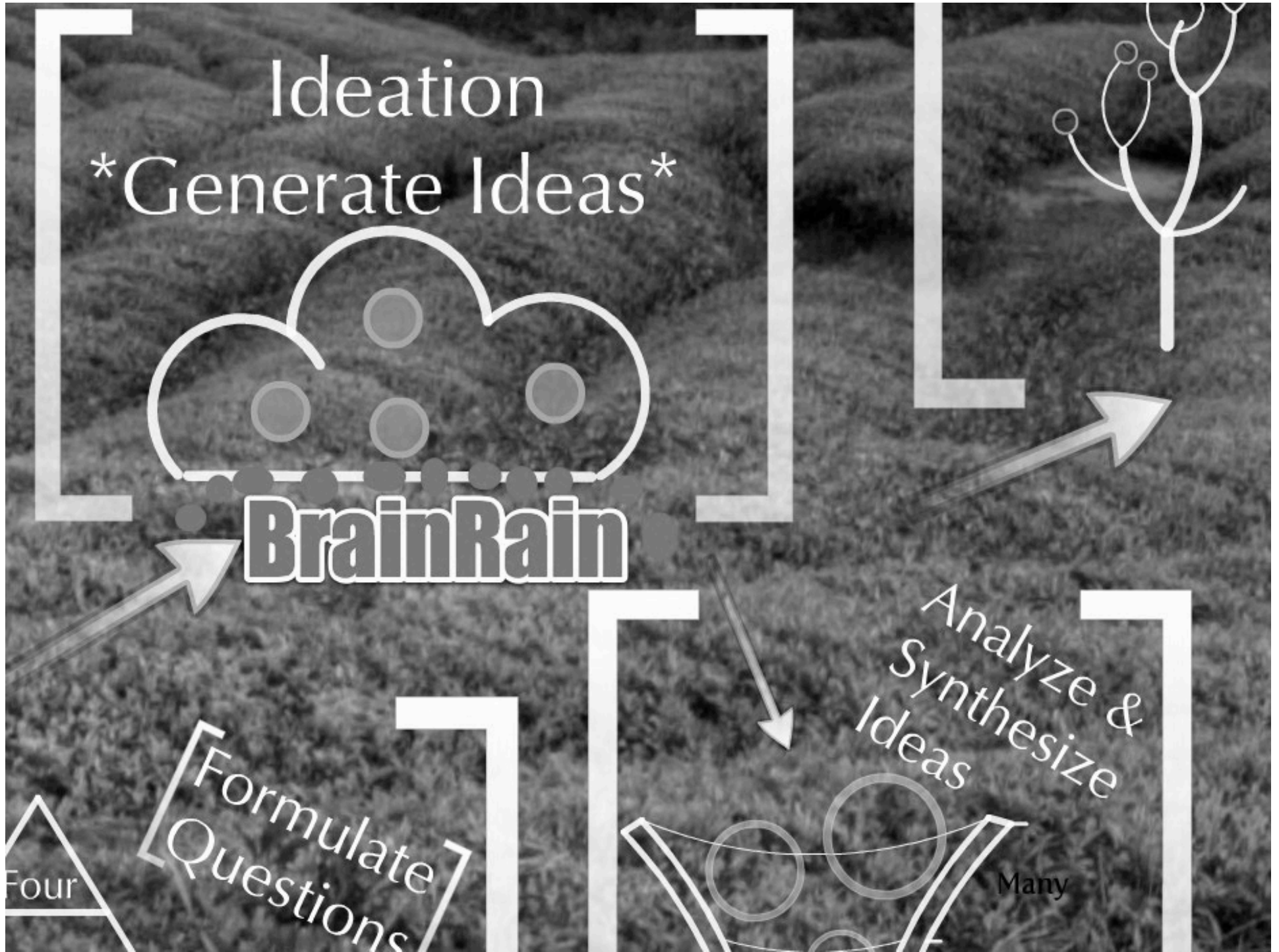

9. Strategic priority project in a dept (ED Distance Ed)
10. Innovation Workshops for and within departments
11. Learning/Doing program for students/all funded through foundation
12. Student initiate funded through student funds to help them innovate
13. Innovate Yourself programs funded by individuals and other sources
14. Grad student interdisciplinary innovation learning series
15. Business school-entrepreneurship program development & facilitation

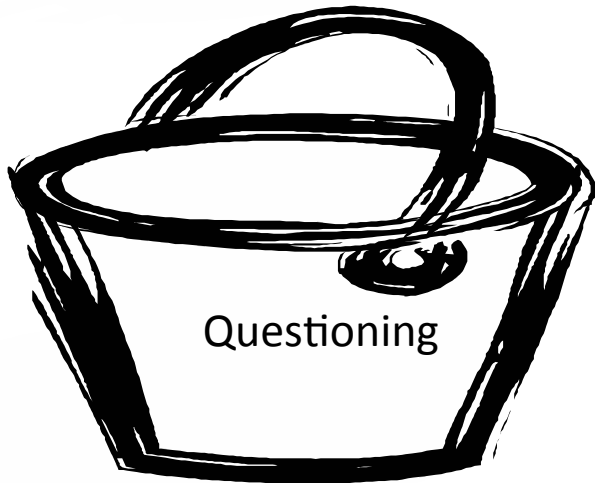

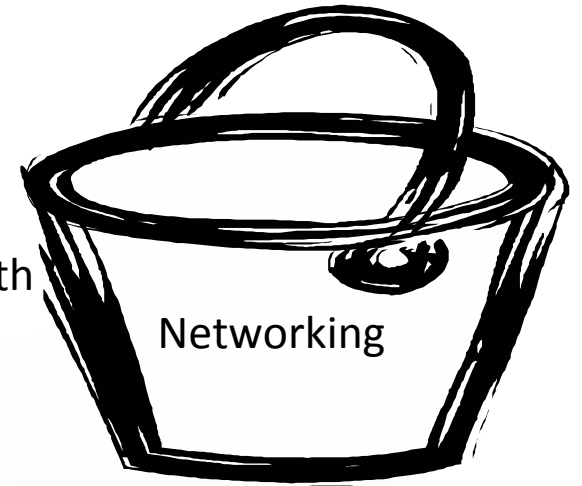
O1. Observe student group meeting with journal to see How students communicate



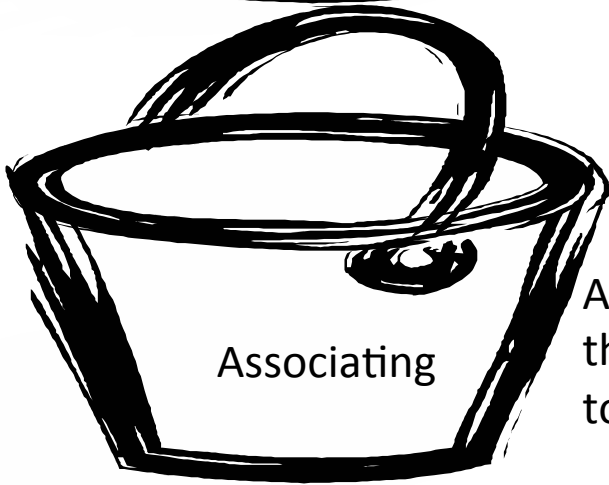
E1. 2 minute experiment in staff meeting with post it note feedback
